Q. How do I change the drive letter of a drive in Windows?



Solution:

Connect the drive to a Windows computer and follow the steps below to change the drive letter of a drive in Windows operating system. The steps are same for Windows XP, Vista and Windows 7.

Step 1: Open Start menu.

<u>Step 2</u>: Right-click on **My Computer** or **Computer**.

<u>Step 3</u>: Left-click on **Manage** to open the Computer Management screen as shown below.

<u>Step 4</u>: Left-click **Disk Management** on the left pane of Computer Management screen.

Step 5: On the Disk Management screen choose the Verbatim drive from the lower half of the screen and right-click on it.
